## **Chadur Lakcha Jaba Homam**

Chadur Lakcha Jaba Homam is an important ritual held at Sri Layan Sithi Vinayagar Temple. Chadur means four and Lakcham means hundred thousand. This ritual hence consists of chanting Vinayagar Moolamantra four hundred thousand times, along with forty thousand homa aavarthis offering to the ritual fire. The belief is that this ritual reinforces the power of the presiding deity and thereby enhances His blessings to the devotees manifold.

### ***Purpose of conducting the Homam***

The homam is conducted so that with the recitations of the mantras, the divine powers of Vinayagar are multiplied. He blesses us by removing all our obstructions in life, bestowing upon us all the benefits that are required for a successful life, subdues the elements so that there are less natural disasters and strengthens the harmony of the nation.

### ***Duration for the conduct of Chadur Lakcha Jaba Homam***

The 10 day homam starts on Thursday, the 2nd of the month Avani in the Hindu year Subakiruthu and ends on Saturday, the 11<sup>th</sup> of Avani **(18.8.2022 to 27.8.2022)**.

### **Payments**

Devotees wishing to take part in the Chadur Lakcha Jaba Homam for a continuous period of ten days, should pay **\$1101/-** by providing their names and nakshatra. Alternatively, devotees can also take part in a specific day by paying **\$121/-** per person.

### ***Prasad***

- For 10 days participation (\$1101), devotees will receive Single gold capped rudhraksham on a silver threaded rudhraksha maalai on the final (10<sup>th</sup>) day of the homam).
- For 1 day participation (\$121), devotees will get Single silver capped rudhraksham on a threaded rudhraksha maalai.

Devotees are requested to take part in this Chadur Lakcha Jaba Homam by paying the relevant fees and seek the blessings of Sri Layan Sithi Vinayagar.
